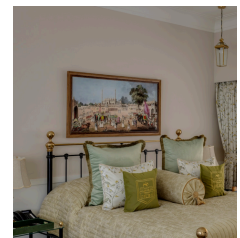


LUXURY ACCOMMODATION:

TOURIST ATTRACTIONS

- Vashishta Gufa: A sacred cave located just a short drive away, offering a serene retreat for spiritual seekers.
- Haridwar: A bustling town known for its vibrant culture and sacred ghats, where guests can witness the mesmerizing Ganga Aarti ceremony.
- Dehradun: The capital city of Uttarakhand, renowned for its picturesque landscapes, colonial architecture, and vibrant street markets.
- Ganga Aarti Rishikesh: Triveni Ghat and Parmarth Niketan Ashram Ghat stand as iconic landmarks in Rishikesh, offering spiritual sanctuaries along the banks of the sacred Ganges. Located approximately 20 kilometres from Narendra Nagar, Rishikesh, these ghats are easily accessible by a scenic drive lasting around 45 minutes. Visitors can experience the mesmerizing Ganga Aarti ceremonies held daily between 6:00 PM and 7:00 PM at both Triveni Ghat and Parmarth Niketan, immersing themselves in the spiritual ambiance of the holy river.



DISTANCE FROM AIRPORT:

Kinwani House is conveniently located approximately 25 kilometres away/45 minutes from Dehradun's Jolly Grant Airport, providing easy access for travellers. Additionally, it's approximately 20 kilometres/ 35 minutes from Rishikesh Railway Station, offering seamless connectivity for guests arriving by train.
